The Start for Life offer is helping families to give their children the best start in life, with support during pregnancy to the age of 5.

It brings together information on local support and additional support services focused on families with children aged 0-5.

A free pregnancy and parenting app that provides new and expecting families in Southwark with a digital tool where they can access locally relevant and accurate information during pregnancy and the first year of their baby's life.

Infant Feeding

We have great infant feeding support across Southwark's Children & Family Hub network providing new parents with access to breastfeeding drop ins, a network of peer support and information and advice to achieve their infant feeding goals.

Healthy Minds Thrive

We deliver support to parents through the emotional ups and downs of parenting, helping them with their mental well-being and to build good attachment and relationships with their baby.

We have a dedicated parenting mental health service working directly with parents of 0-2s, as well as trained well-being champions on-site in every community offering practical help and support.



Early Language and Home Learning Environment

We have trained staff in all hubs and communities who can provide practical advice and support to help parents create a rich and resourceful learning environment for their children.

Our staff can help to understand your child's early language, communication and social development needs and can help access the right services and ensure children are ready for school.

Parenting Support

Help is available to all parents and carers in Southwark through a wide range of services and support with the **everyday challenges** of parenting a baby or child.

This includes activities for parent and child, as well practical tips and resources, targeted parenting programmes and peer support for all parents including for fathers and coparents.
